You need additionally

Threads:

- cotton or polyester threads that match the fabrics.
- cotton or polyester bobbin thread

Tips from Kati:

Wildflowers are wonderful decorations on garments and bags too. Feel free to create them separately and use them as embellishments.

Others:

- pressing foot, darning foot (optional)
- marking pencil,
- pins, (basting spray)
- sharp scissors
- rulers, rotary cutter, cutting mat
- light box or window
- iron, ironing board
